

#### Word Wall Words – Ch and Sh


This is all new to me, so I hope this document is downloadable and printable — any problems, please let me know, so I can figure out what I may or may not be doing wrong!

I use these as flashcards, as well as for putting up on our 'Word Wall' as a reference for children to use when completing phoneme/digraph related work during the week. Depending on how much support children need with a given phoneme, I might leave all or a few of the words up throughout the month/term/year (take your pick!).


As I'm in an open plan classroom, I don't have unlimited wall space, so I do often have to take cards down, even when I might like to leave them up for longer. I keep the words available for my class, however, by using 'retired phoneme' pockets – when the 'ch' and 'sh' phonemes need to come down to make room for subsequent phonemes, I transfer the 'ch' & 'sh' labels onto pockets tacked to the wall. I then place all of the wall word cards in the correct folder – if and when kids need them, they are still available, but they aren't using up all of the available 'Word Wall' space.
