Picture Flashcards –

AW

For the AW flashcards, I've included a variety of different types of words, so you can focus on those (or do a mini-lesson using them) if you'd like.

There are:

- **Because** – such an important word to know! Difficult to picture, but I've put in the well known elephant mnemonic.
- 4 simple 1 syllable words (haul, Paul, taut, fault)
- 4 slightly more challenging words (Laura, sauce, pause, launch)
- 4 2 syllable words (August, autumn, haunted, cauldron), with an additional 3 syllable word (astronaut)
- 3 'aught' words – these are words kids can come across more frequently than we think – so I like to teach this pattern when I'm teaching 'au' (of course, you always have exceptions, like 'laugh' – but what are you going to do?)

These different types of words make it easier to use them to teach specific skills – I hope you find these helpful! Please let me know of other ways you use these cards, or other skills you target with them.

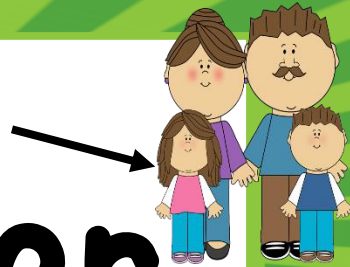

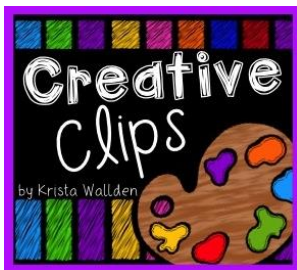
