




I use these wall words as flashcards when I introduce a new Phoneme/digraph – after we read each word together as a class, the word card is transferred onto our Word Wall (there are always many children who want to help with this!).

In this pack, you'll find:

- 6 simple ea words: eat, sea, seal, meal, read, leaf. I have included 'leaves' in case it would be useful – you can use it to highlight how leaf changes when it is plural (or not, if that would confuse your kiddos!)
- 10 ea words with beginning or ending blends or digraphs (ch): wheat, reach, clean, Stream, cream, least, teach, Steam, speak, peach.
- 4 ea verbs with the ing ending: cleaning, steaming, teaching, speaking.

I hope these save you some time, help you differentiate, and you find them useful and colourful! I'd love to hear how you use them in your own classroom. ©


