

Picture Flashcards – EW

For the EW flashcards, I've included a variety of different types of words, so you can focus on those (or do a minilesson using them) if you'd like.


There are:

- 4 simple 3 letter words (new, pew, few, dew)
- 5 simple 4 letter words (drew, flew, blew, crew, grew), with an extra 5 letter word (screw) – useful for looking at beginning blends
- 3 longer/tricker words (jewel, view, fewer) 'ew' is rarely in the middle of words, unless it has a word ending (e.g., crewing), so jewel is unusual. I've included 'view' because the 'i' makes it tricky I'll also use it with 'interview', to help build the skill of recognising smaller words within words (same with few/fewer)
- 4 compound words (corkscrew, dewdrop, screwdriver, honeydew).


These different types of words make it easier to use them to teach specific skills — I hope you find these helpful! Please let me know of other ways you use these cards, or other skills you target with them.




