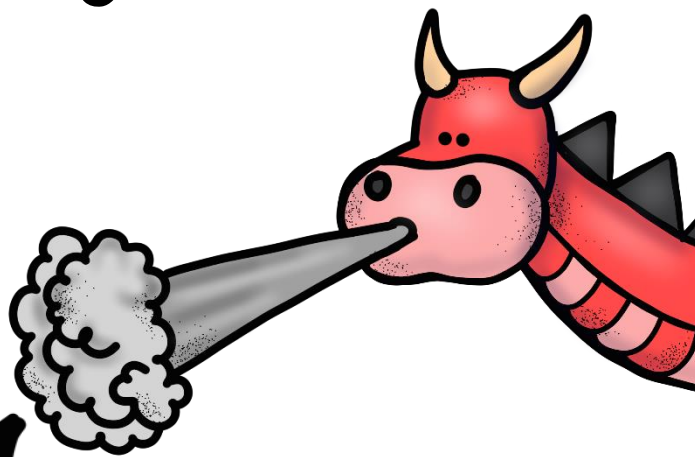

O-E

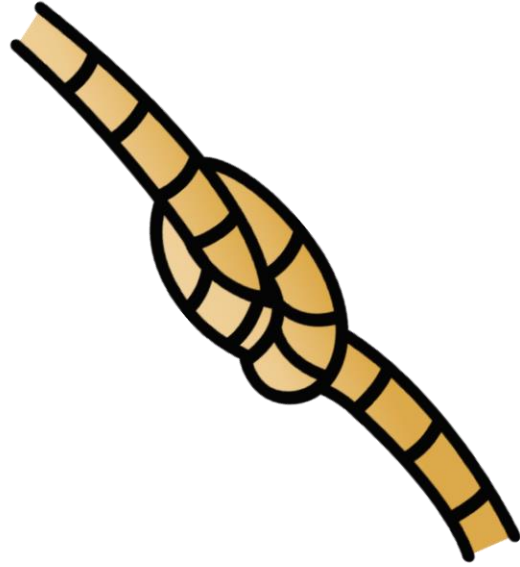
I use these wall words as flashcards when I introduce a new phoneme/digraph – after we read each word together as a class, the word card is transferred onto our Word Wall (there are always many children who want to help with this!).

In this pack, you'll find:

- 5 simple o-e words (home, rose, rope, nose, cone)
- 4 o-e words with silent letter (gnome) or initial blends (stone, globe, smoke)
- 4 more challenging o-e words (tadpole, microscope, telescope, envelope). The print on these is smaller, but it might only be appropriate to use these with a smaller reading group in your class.

I hope these save you some time, help you differentiate, and you find them useful and colourful! I'd love to hear how you use them in your own classroom. ☺
