


## OU Wall Words


These flashcards are a great way to introduce new phonemes to your class, as well as being a colourful addition to your 'Word Wall', for your students to use as a reference throughout the week.


Types of words included:


- 5 simple 1 syllable words (out, noun, hour, ouch, sour), with 2 additional 1 syllable words that are slightly trickier to spell (mouse, house).
- 9 words to work on blends (plus 'mouth' a 'th' word). Beginning blends: cloud, flour, snout, trout. Ending blends: round, sound, mound, pound. Both ending ξ beginning blends: ground.
- I added in 'bounce' because the 'soft s' c words can be tricky – always good to highlight them (c makes an 's' sound after the letters 'e, i, y' – so we often talk about how bossy those letters are) – then I've added in 3 additional words with an 'y' ending – bouncy, cloudy, mouthy. As the root words are all also included, these will be useful when we are working on ending 'y' words.

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












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
