### Word Wall Words - 55




In this resource, there are:






In this resource, there are:




### Word Wall Words - FF


In this resource, there are:


- · 4 simple ff words: off, cuff, puff, muff
- 4 simple ff words with initial blends: sniff, staff, cliff, stiff
- 4 more complex ff words: sheriff, buffalo, daffodil, giraffe
- 4 compound ff words: earmuff, liftoff, takeoff, handcuff






