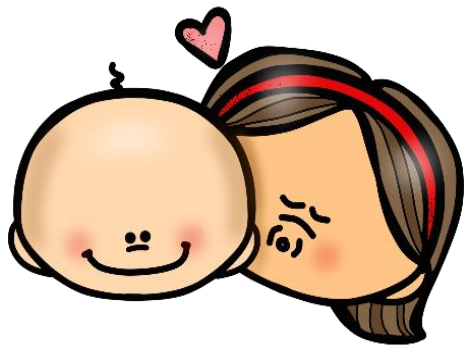

I use these as flashcards, to introduce our new phoneme (or review a previously taught one) They then go up on our 'Word Wall' as a reference for children to use when completing phoneme/digraph related work during the week. Depending on how much support children need with a given phoneme, I might leave all or a few of the words up throughout the month/term/year (take your pick!).

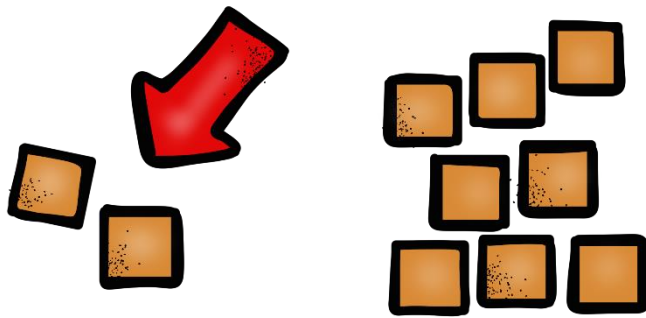
In this resource, there are:

- 4 simple ss words with initial blends (glass, grass, press, bless)
- 4 2 syllable ss words: across, dismiss, discuss, compass

I hope you find these useful, and the different types of words make it easier to differentiate your instruction for your class.

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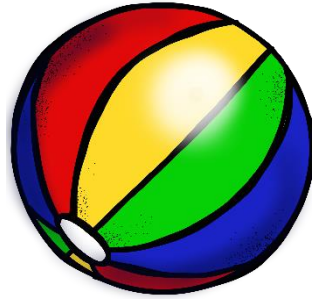

Word Wall Words - FF

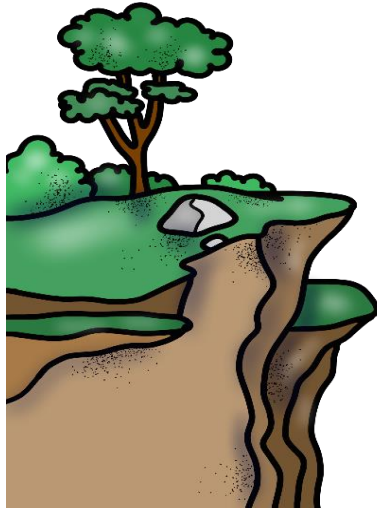
In this resource, there are:

- 4 more complex ff words: sheriff, buffalo, daffodil, giraffe
- 4 compound ff words: earmuff, liftoff, takeoff, handcuff

I hope you find these useful, and the different types of words make it easier to differentiate your instruction for your class. Remember – you know your own children, and some of the words might not be appropriate for them. While you are more than welcome to print off all of the flashcards, keep in mind that, because the cards are in difficulty order, you can save ink by only printing out the cards you need!

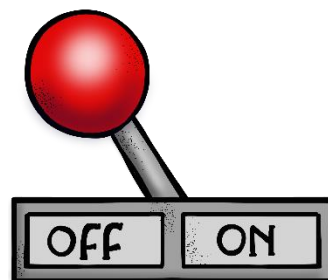

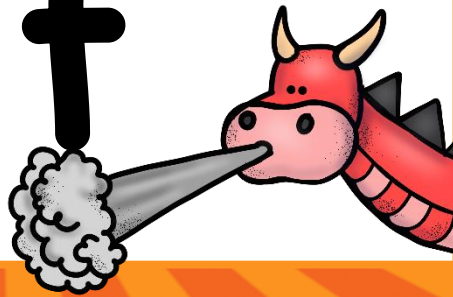

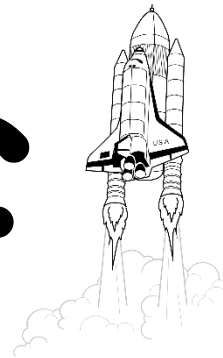
